Dive description	Mixon Hole: (boat dive with Mulberry Divers) Depth: up to 28m. The Mixon Hole lies at the Eastern end of the Looe Channel. Divers are dropped off just in front of the Cardinal Marker in a depth of 5-6m; a short swim south / south-east brings you to the cliff edge - this shallow area on top has luxuriant marine growth and life. The blue clay cliff drops vertically to a gravel bottom - there are occasional crabs and lobsters where boulders are dotted into the clay. The Hounds: (shore dive) Depth: 5m approx. This site is just to the east of the launch ramp, where there are areas of mixed ground and a few pipes. This area is home to a wide variety of marine life.
