What to bring:	<p>Divers need to provide all their own kit (or arrange hire). This is to include a SMB (or dSMB); a torch is also recommended. Divers are reminded they will need air for <u>two</u> dives.</p> <p>Please bring any snacks and refreshments you may wish to have throughout the day. Tea and coffee will be available on the boat.</p>
